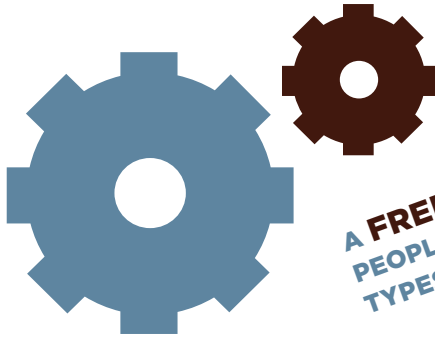

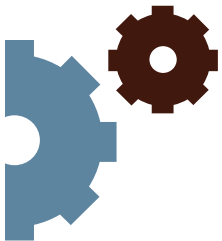
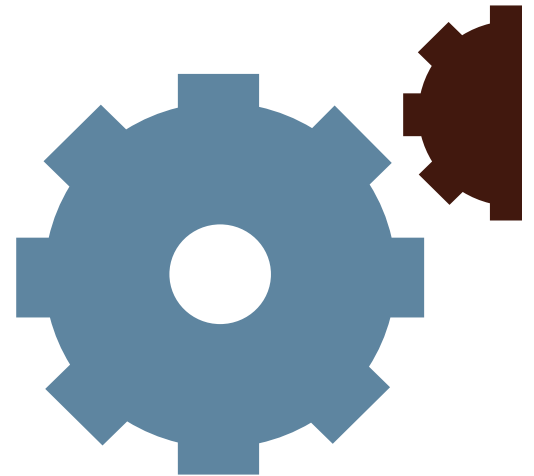
- Finding support at each stage of the brain tumor journey
